AN ACT to legalize the acts of Pleasant Ridge Plantation in
the County of Somerset.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That the acts and doings of the plantation of
2 Pleasant Ridge in Somerset county at the annual meeting
3 in March, A. D. 1905, and at all subsequent meetings be
4 made legal and valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
