IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Bonneg Beg pond, in Sanford  
and North Berwick, in the County of York.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or  
kill any trout or white perch in Bonneg Beg pond, in San-  
ford and North Berwick, at any time for a period of three  
years.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act  
shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the  
general law of the state for illegal fishing.
