STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Spear stream in the County
of Oxford, also its tributaries.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in Spear
3 stream, so called, in the county of Oxford, except that on
4 Tuesday and Thursday of each week it shall be lawful to
5 fish therein in accordance with the general law of the state.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish at any
2 time for any kind of fish in any of the tributaries to said
3 Spear stream.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars

3 nor more than thirty dollars for each offense and costs, and
4 a further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught,
5 killed, or had in possession in violation of the provisions of
6 this act.
