IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the protection of deer in York County.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for deer  
2 in the county of York from December first to October  
3 thirty-first following of each year in which it shall be unlaw-  
4 ful to hunt, chase, catch or kill any deer. It shall be unlaw-  
5 ful to hunt, chase, catch or kill any female deer at any time  
6 in said county and no person shall catch or kill more than  
7 one buck deer in said county and it shall be unlawful to  
8 have in possession more than one buck deer which has been  
9 killed in said county.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in

3 the general law of the state for illegal hunting, chasing,  
4 killing and being in possession of deer.

Sect. 3. All laws inconsistent with this act are hereby  
2 repealed.
