## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the protection of deer in York County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for deer
- 2 in the county of York from December first to October
- 3 thirty-first following of each year in which it shall be unlaw-
- 4 ful to hunt, chase, catch or kill any deer. It shall be unlaw-
- 5 ful to hunt, chase, catch or kill any female deer at any time
- 6 in said county and no person shall catch or kill more than
- 7 one buck deer in said county and it shall be unlawful to
- 8 have in possession more than one buck deer which has been
- 9 killed in said county.
- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in

- 3 the general law of the state for illegal hunting, chasing,
- 4 killing and being in possession of deer.
- Sect. 3. All laws inconsistent with this act are hereby 2 repealed.
