STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved: That the trustees of insane hospitals be 2 instructed to cause to be executed a contract between the 3 State and the Augusta water district for an additional supply 4 of water for use at the Insane Hospital at Augusta, by the 5 terms of which the State shall pay annually to the water 6 district 15 per cent on the cost of construction by the dis-7 trict of a 10 inch main pipe to the hospital grounds for the 8 exclusive use of the hospital. Said rental to commence to 9 run on completion of such main ready for use and to con-10 tinue till the expiration of the existing contract for water 11 now in force with the water system now owned by said 12 district.

Also said contract shall provide for the supply of neces-14 sary water for the arsenal grounds and buildings for which 15 the State shall pay 10 cents per 1000 gallons and forty dol-16 lars each, per year, for four hydrants.

Also that the sum of seventy-three hundred dollars be and 18 hereby is appropriated for and to be used in payment of 19 water pipe and laying of the same through hospital and 20 arsenal grounds for the conveyance of the additional water 21 and the installing of a pump for fire purposes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

For laying a ten inch main pipe line through arsenal and hospital grounds and the installing of a pump for fire purposes.
