## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the open season on duck in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In addition to the general law it shall be lawful 2 to hunt, chase, catch, kill and have in possession, in accord-3 ance with the provisions of the general law, in the county 4 of Lincoln, wood duck, commonly called black duck, teal, 5 and any and all ducks known as gadwall or gray duck, mal-6 lard, widgeon or baldpate, shoveler, pintail or sprigtail, red-7 head, scaup duck or greater blue-bill, lesser scaup duck or 8 lesser blue-bill, golden-eye or whistler, buffle-head, ruddy 9 duck or broad-bill, from the first day of December of each 10 year to the first day of the following February.

- Sect. 2. The provisions of this act shall in no way change 2 the laws now in force relating to the hunting of ducks and
- 3 waterfowl on the Kennebec river and in Merrymeeting Bay.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in
- 3 the general law of the state for the illegal hunting, catching,
- 4 killing and having in possession of game birds.
