IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 248 of the Private and Special Laws of 1905, amendatory to section three of chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, relating to the time and number of fish that can be taken in the streams lying wholly or partly in the towns of Freeman, Salem and Strong.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 248 of the Private and Special Laws of 1905 is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
