Resolved: That the county commissioners of Washington 2 county are hereby authorized and directed to repay to the 3 town of Baring any part of the county taxes which said 4 town has paid, which may have been assessed on account of 5 an error or mistake in the valuation over and above the true 6 valuation of said town in the year nineteen hundred five 7 and nineteen hundred six.

The assessors of the town of Baring made an error in the report to the state assessors and county commissioners in the valuation, for which taxes were assessed for the years 1905 and 1906.
