
AN ACT to amend section one of chapter three hundred and seventeen of the Special Laws of 1901, entitled "An Act to protect lobsters in the waters adjacent to the shores of the town of Lubec and Trescott."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter three hundred and

- 2 seventeen of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-
- 3 dred and one is hereby amended by adding after the word
- 4 "of" in the second line the words 'January and the first day
- 5 of April, and also between the first day of,' so that said
- 6 section will read as amended:

'Sect. I. No person shall catch, kill or destroy any lobsters 8 between the first day of January and the first day of April, 9 and also between the first day of July and the first day of 10 October in each year under a penalty of one dollar for each 11 and every lobster so taken, caught, killed or destroyed in 12 the waters adjacent to the towns of Lubec and Trescott.
