IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section forty-one of chapter twenty-three
of the Revised Statutes relating to the powers, liabilities and
penalties of plantations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section forty-one of chapter twenty-three of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "required to assess a state and county tax" in the
4 first line of said section and inserting in place thereof the
5 words 'organized under section one hundred and fourteen
6 of chapter four of the Revised Statutes,' so that said section,
7 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. Plantations organized under section one hundred
9 and fourteen of chapter four of the Revised Statutes have

10 like powers and are subject to like liabilities and penalties
11 as towns respecting ways. Their assessors have like powers
12 and shall perform like duties, as municipal officers of towns,
13 respecting them.
