Resolved: That the land agent of the State of Maine be 2 and he hereby is authorized to sell for cash to actual settlers 3 lots numbered ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-4 seven, ninety-eight, ninety-nine, one hundred, one hundred 5 one, one hundred two, one hundred three, one hundred four, 6 one hundred five, one hundred six, one hundred seven, one 7 hundred eight and one hundred ten in township numbered 8 eighteen, range five, W. E. L. S.: and also lots numbered 9 one hundred eight, one hundred nine, one hundred ten, one 10 hundred sixty, and one hundred sixty-one in township num-11 bered eighteen, range four, W. E. L. S.
