RESOLVE, that the land grant agent be authorized to convey to Lemuel H. Stover of Brunswick, Maine, certain ledges in Casco Bay known as "Irony Island."

Resolved: That the land agent of the State of Maine, be

3 of Brunswick, Maine, the ledge or ledges in Casco Bay,
4 lying near the islands known as "The Gaslins" now owned
5 by the said Stover, and which are known as "Irony Island."
