STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Wesserunsett stream and tribu-
taries, in the County of Somerset.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Wesserunsett stream, so
3 called in the county of Somerset, or in any of its tributaries,
4 for a period of five years from May first, A. D. 1907.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor
3 more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a
4 further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught,
5 killed or had in possession in violation of the provisions
6 hereof.
