## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Wesserunsett stream and tributaries, in the County of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or

- 2 kill any kind of fish at any time in Wesserunsett stream, so
- 3 called in the county of Somerset, or in any of its tributaries,
- 4 for a period of five years from May first, A. D. 1907.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act

- 2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor
- 3 more than thirty dollars and costs for each offense and a
- 4 further penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught,
- 5 killed or had in possession in violation of the provisions
- 6 hereof.
