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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to repeal chapter five hundred eighty-two of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight, and chapter one hundred ninety-one of the Special Laws of nineteen hundred three, relating to the taking of codfish, pollock, hake and haddock in the waters of Frenchmenn's Bay.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter five hundred eighty-two of the Special  
2 Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight and chapter one hun-  
3 dred ninety-one of the Special Laws of nineteen hundred  
4 three, both entitled, "An Act to regulate the taking of cod-  
5 fish, pollock, hake and haddock in the waters of Frenchmen's  
6 bay" are hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
