
STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to repeal chapter five hundred eighty-two of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight, and chapter one hundred ninety-one of the Special Laws of nineteen hundred three, relating to the taking of codfish, pollock, hake and haddock in the waters of Frenchmenn's Bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Chapter five hundred eighty-two of the Special
- 2 Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-eight and chapter one hun-
- 3 dred ninety-one of the Special Laws of nineteen hundred
- 4 three, both entitled, "An Act to regulate the taking of cod-
- 5 fish, pollock, hake and haddock in the waters of Frenchmen's
- 6 bay" are hereby repealed.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
