IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Cochnewagon, Dexter, Berry
and Wilson ponds, in the County of Kennebec.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish at any time for any
2 kind of fish through the ice in Cochnewagon, Dexter, Berry
3 or Wilson ponds, situated wholly or partly in the towns of
4 Monmouth, Winthrop and Wayne, in the county of Ken-
5 nebec.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in
3 the general law of the State for illegal fishing.
