STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of screening Kingsbury pond, in the
County of Piscataquis.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated for the purpose of screening Kingsbury
3 pond, so called, in the county of Piscataquis, to be expended
4 under the direction of the commissioners of inland fisheries
5 and game, when the balance necessary to erect said screen,
6 as found by the commissioners, shall have been raised by the
7 citizens of the county of Piscataquis and paid into the treas-
8 ury of state for this purpose—to aid in the erection of said
9 screen.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be avail-
11 able until the town of Kingsbury shall have, in legal town
12 meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town

13 meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume
14 all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times from
15 sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become
16 clogged and prevent the free running of the water through
17 the same.
