IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-four of chapter forty-nine of the Revised Statutes, providing a lien for a mortgagee of any mortgage of personal property upon any policy of insurance on such property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section fifty-four of chapter forty-nine of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the
- 3 words "real estate" in the first line of said section the words
- 4 'and the mortgagee of any personal property,' so that said
- 5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 54. The mortgagee of any real estate and the mort-

- 7 gagee of any personal property shall have a lien upon any
- 8 policy of insurance against loss by fire procured thereon by

of the mortgagor, to take effect from the time he files with the secretary of the company a written notice, briefly describing his mortgage, the estate conveyed thereby, and the sum remaining unpaid thereon. If the mortgagor, by a writing by him signed, and filed with the secretary, consents that the whole of the sum secured by the policy, or so much as is required to discharge the amount due on the mortgage at the time when a loss occurs, shall be applied to the payment of the mortgage, it shall be so paid by the company and the mortgagee's receipt therefor shall be a sufficient discharge of the company.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
