IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the protection of female deer in Cumberland county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or kill

- 2 any female deer at any time within the county of Cumber-
- 3 land for the term of two years, under the penalty provided
- 4 in the general law for illegal hunting or killing of deer.

Sect. 2. All laws inconsistent with this act are hereby 2 repealed.
