STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT in relation to fares upon the Washington County Railway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The Washington County Railway Company is 2 hereby required, for the purposes of passenger traffic, to 3 issue and sell mileage books, or tickets corresponding in 4 form to mileage books, good for one thousand miles, and 5 transferable by delivery to the bearer thereof, at the rate of 6 two cents per mile, to all applying and so paying therefor.

Sect. 2. For each violation of this act said corporation 2 shall forfeit one hundred dollars to be recovered by indict-3 ment or by action on the case brought by any person injured 4 by such violation.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1907.
