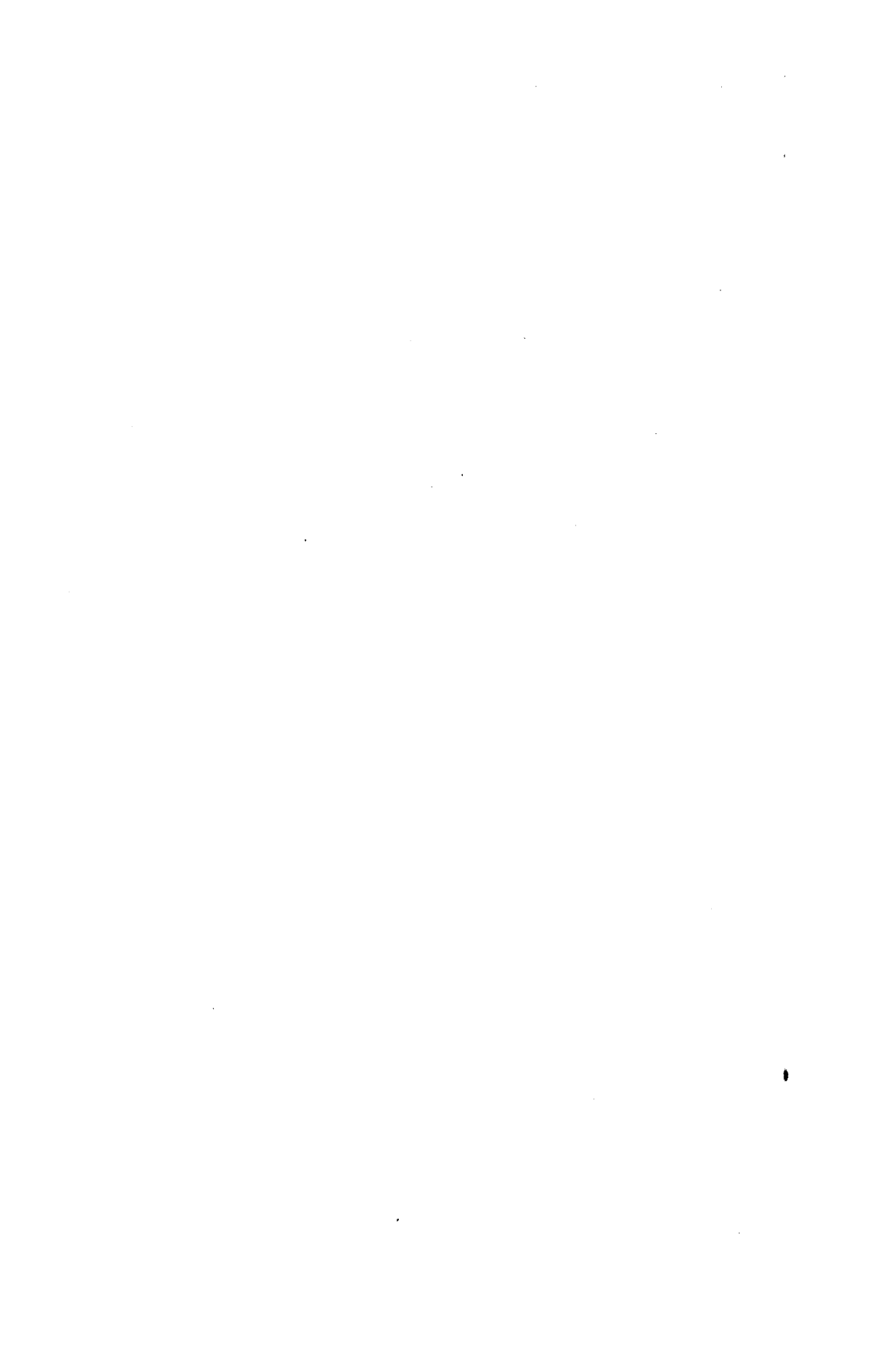

Resolved: That the sum of four hundred dollars is hereby

3 Verona across the eastern thoroughfare of Penobscot river,

5 town and expended under the direction of the selectmen of
