STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for the repair of bridges in Macwahoc
plantation.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars for repairing the
3 bridge across Molunkus stream and the bridge across Mac-
4 wahoc stream, both being on the state military road, so
5 called, in Macwahoc plantation in the county of Aroostook,
6 provided that the money hereby appropriated shall be ex-
7 pended under the direction of the state commissioner of
8 highways and the county commissioners of Aroostook county
9 and the unexpended balance, if any, shall be returned to the
10 state treasury.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridges across the Molunkus stream and Macwahoc stream in Macwahoc plantation are on the old "state military road," so called, from Mattawamkeag to Haynesville. These bridges were built by the state and have always been maintained by the state. The amount named in the resolve is **absolutely** necessary for repairs. The bridge across Molunkus stream is a wooden covered bridge one hundred and forty-five feet long. The roof of this bridge is so badly out of repair that the rain and snow are rotting the timbers and seriously injuring the main structure of the bridge.
