AN ACT relating to proceedings to determine the title to goods in the possession of common carriers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The supreme judicial court shall have jurisdic-2 tion is equity to sustain bills of interpleader notwithstanding

- 3 the complainant is a common carrier and as such has a lien
- 4 for carriage or storage upon the property which is described 5 in the bill.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
