IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to proceedings to determine the title to goods
in the possession of common carriers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The supreme judicial court shall have jurisdic-
tion is equity to sustain bills of interpleader notwithstanding
the complainant is a common carrier and as such has a lien
for carriage or storage upon the property which is described
in the bill.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
