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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend chapter 52, section 7 of the Revised Statutes relating to fraudulent evasions of payment of fares on steam railroads, street railroads, steamboats and ferries.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 7 of chapter 52 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 7. No person is entitled to transportation over a 4 stream railroad, street railroad or upon any steamboat or 5 ferry who does not on demand first pay the established fare. 6 Whoever while being transported over any steam railroad, 7 street railroad, steamboat or ferry, willfully refuses on 8 demand to pay the established fare and whoever fraud- 9 ulently evades payment of the established fare by giving a

10 false answer, or by traveling beyond the place to which he  
11 has paid, or by leaving a train, street railroad car, steamboat  
12 or ferry without paying the established fare, forfeits not less  
13 than five or more than twenty dollars, to be recovered on  
14 complaint.
