STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to prevent the hauling of heavy teams on the highways of Brooklin from the fifteenth of March to the tenth of May.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or party to

- 2 haul a load by more than one yoke of oxen or one pair of
- 3 horses as a team upon the highways of the town of Brooklin
- 4 in the county of Hancock between the fifteenth day of March
- 5 and the tenth day of May of each year, except by a written
- 6 permit signed by the three municipal officers.
 - Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate section one of this act shall
- 2 on conviction of the same be punished by a fine of not less
- 3 than ten or more than twenty-five dollars for each and every
- 4 offense.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
