STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to establish the salary of State superintendent of schools and further define his duties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The salary of the State superintendent of 2 schools is hereby established at twenty-five hundred dollars 3 per annum. He shall receive in addition his actual cash 4 expenses incurred in the performance of his official duties 5 which sum shall be paid out of the specific appropriation for 6 that purpose. He shall perform his official duties at the 7 office provided for him at the seat of government and not 8 elsewhere, not meaning, however, to prohibit him from mak-9 ing such necessary journeys and performing such duties as

10 are necessary or incidental to the immediate object of such 11 journey.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
