IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT relating to the operation of motor vehicles on public
streets and ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section seven of chapter twenty-four of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "eight" in the seventh line thereof and inserting the word
4 'five' in its place, so that said section as amended shall read
5 as follows:

'Sect. 7. No automobile or motor vehicle shall be driven
7 or operated upon any highway, townway, public street, ave-
8 nue, driveway, park or parkway, at a greater rate of speed
9 than fifteen miles an hour, or upon any highway, townway,
10 public street, avenue, driveway, park or parkway within the

11 compact or built up portions of any city, town or village, the
12 limit of which shall be fixed by the municipal officers thereof,
13 at a greater rate of speed than five miles an hour, except
14 where such city or town may by ordinance or by-law permit
15 a greater rate of speed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
