STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to extend the close season on landlocked salmon and trout in Sebago Lake, in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time for land-

- 2 locked salmon and trout in Sebago Lake, in the County of
- 3 Cumberland, from September first of each year to April first
- 4 of the following year, during which time it shall be un'awful
- 5 to fish for, take, catch or kill any trout or landlocked salmon
- 6 in this lake, and it shall also be unlawful during this time
- 7 to have in possession any trout or landlocked salmon taken
- 8 from this lake. Provided, however, that it shall be lawful
- 9 to fish in this lake through the ice in accordance with the
- 10 provisions of the general law of the State.

- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act 2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the 3 general law of the State for illegal fishing.
- Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act 2 are hereby repealed.
