STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Belgrade stream, so called, in
the County of Kennebec.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish in Belgrade stream,
2 so called, from a point 200 feet below the bridge below Bel-
3 grade Depot, so called, to Snow pond, in the town of Bel-
4 grade, county of Kennebec, in accordance with the provisions
5 of the laws applicable to fishing in said Snow pond.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law of the State for illegal fishing.

Sect. 3. Provided, further, that this act shall not take
2 effect until the commissioners of inland fish and game, with-
3 out expense to the State, have caused notices to be posted
4 in conspicuous places at or near the waters herein described
5 setting forth in substance the provisions of this act.
