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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to amend section two of the Private and Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred seven entitled, "An Act to amend the third paragraph of section fifty-one of chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to supreme judicial courts."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section two of the private and special laws of 2 the year nineteen hundred and seven entitled, "An Act to 3 amend the third paragraph of section fifty-one of chapter 4 seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes relating to supreme 5 judicial courts" is hereby amended by adding the following 6 words at the end of said section: 'And it shall be the duty 7 of the presiding justice at the April term of the supreme

8 judicial court of Aroostook county to fix a day for the open-  
9 ing of the adjourned term to be held at Caribou, which day  
10 shall be at least seven days after the announcement of the  
11 day fixed by said justice, and said adjourned term shall open  
12 the day so fixed. And it shall be the duty of the clerk of  
13 courts for Aroostook county immediately to advise all attor-  
14 neys residing in said county of the day so fixed.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
