## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to establish an additional normal school to be located at Dexter in the county of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Another normal school to be known as the Cen-
- 2 tral Maine Normal School is hereby created and established3 on such plans as the board of trustees of normal schools
- 4 may direct.
  - Sect. 2. Said normal schools shall be located at Dexter
- 2 in the county of Penobscot, provided and upon condition
- 3 that the inhabitants of said town of Dexter shall within six
- 4 months after the date of the approval of this act cause to be

5 conveyed to the State of Maine free of cost to the State for 6 the use and purposes of said normal school a suitable and 7 sufficient lot of land in said town of Dexter to be approved 8 by the board of trustees of normal schools.

Provided also that said normal school building when com-10 pleted and furnished ready for occupancy shall not cost the 11 State of Maine in excess of the sum of twenty thousand 12 dollars.

Provided also that the town of Dexter shall perpetually 14 furnish water and sewer to said school free of cost to the 15 State.

Provided further that before the above amount shall be-17 come available for said purposes the inhabitants of said town 18 of Dexter at a legal meeting duly called shall, by major vote 19 thereof, accept the conditions of this act, and a certified 20 copy of the record thereof shall be transmitted by the clerk 21 of said town of Dexter to the Treasurer of State. The 22 trustees of normal schools upon conveyance and delivery of 23 sufficient deed of such lot of land to the State and upon noti-24 fication that the conditions of this act have been accepted by 25 the inhabitants of said town of Dexter as herein provided, 26 are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to begin the 27 erection of suitable and proper buildings thereon for the 28 purposes aforesaid and suitably equip said buildings when 29 erected, and secure the teachers to put in operation such 30 schools.

- Sect. 3. The sum of ten thousand dollars is hereby appro-2 priated for the year nineteen hundred seven and a like sum 3 for the year nineteen hundred eight for the purposes of this 4 act.
- Sect. 4. Said sums shall not be available unless the inhabi2 tants of said Dexter shall donate, or cause to be donated,
  3 and convey to the State of Maine such lands as is provided
  4 for in section two of this act, and unless said inhabitants shall
  5 accept the conditions of this act as provided in said section
  6 two.
  - Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
