HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE DOCUMENT No. 108.

Provided, however, that if horse railroads or electric rail2 roads are operated upon such public ways or portions thereof
3 as it may determine to sprinkle at the expense of the abutters,
4 said railroads for the purposes of this act shall be deemed
5 abutters, upon said public ways and assessment shall be
6 made against them upon the amount of space included
7 between the outer rails and one foot beyond on each side
8 extended such distance as said railroad operates on said way
9 or portion thereof to be sprinkled, at the same proportional
10 rate as said space bears to the whole space sprinkled included
11 within said limits of said public way.
