## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 8 of chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes, relating to railroad maps.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 8 of chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended so that said section shall read as follows:

'Every corporation organized as aforesaid shall, within one 4 year after any part of its road has been constructed and 5 opened for operation, cause to be made a map and profile 6 thereof, and of the land taken or obtained for the use thereof, 7 and file the same in the office of the railroad commissioners. 8 Every such map shall be drawn on a scale and on paper to 9 be designated by the board of railroad commissioners, and 10 signed by the president and engineer of the corporation.' Sect. 2. All such plans now on file with the secretary of 2 state shall be transferred to the office of the board of railroad 3 commissioners.
