IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 50 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes relating to the taking of eels in Pemaquid river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 50 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the words, "Pemaguid fort," the
- 3 following: 'and no contrivance of whatever name or nature
- 4 shall be used for the purpose of taking eels from said river
- 5 at any time of the year, with the exception that eels may be
- 6 taken with spear,' so that said section shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 50. From the first day of April to the fifteenth day
- 8 of July in each year, all persons are hereby prohibited from
- 9 fishing with nets, seines, traps, weirs, or any other con-

10 trivance, in that part of Pemaquid river which lies between 11 Pemaquid falls and a line drawn west from the site of the 12 old Pemaquid fort, and no contrivance of whatever name or 13 nature shall be used for the purpose of taking eels from said 14 river at any time of the year, with the exception that eels 15 may be taken with spear, for the term of ten years from the 16 twelfth day of February, nineteen hundred and five. Any 17 person violating any of the provisions of this section shall 18 be subject to a fine of one hundred dollars, and forfeiture of 19 all boats, nets and apparatus used in such illegal fishing.'
