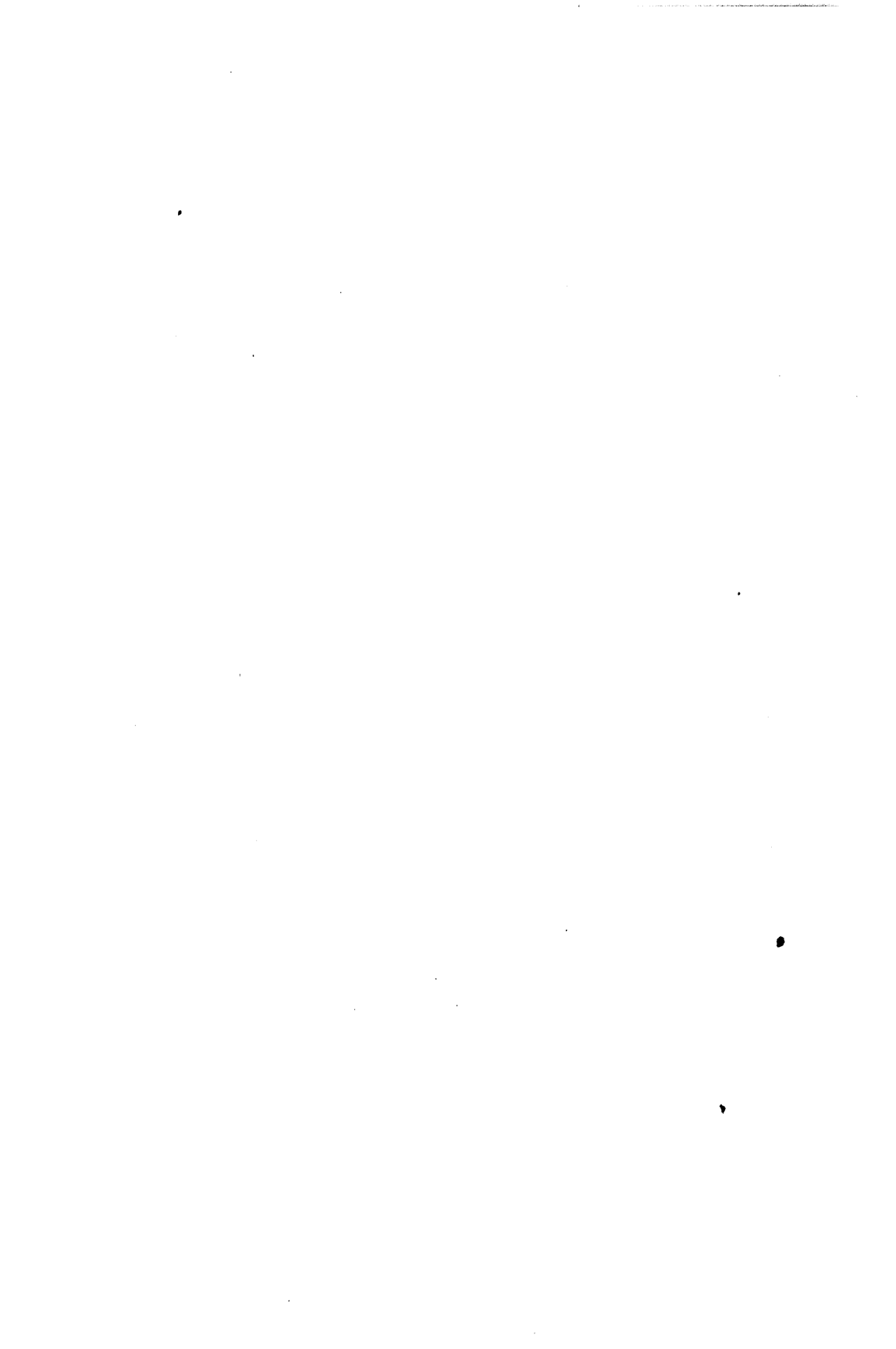
AN ACT to amend section forty-four of chapter nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to the assessment of taxes on lands in places not incorporated.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section forty-four of chapter nine of the Revised Statutes
2 relating to the assessment of taxes on lands in places not
3 incorporated, is hereby amended, and said section as amended
4 shall read as follows:

‘Lands thus forfeited, shall annually in September, be bid
6 in by the land agent of the state in behalf of the inhabitants
7 of the state, and shall be held as the property of said inhab-
8 itants of the state; and the receipt and acknowledgment of
9 the land agent for the lands so bid in, shall be a voucher
10 for the amount of the said tax for the treasurer in the settle-
11 ment of his accounts.’
