### STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Gray.

Resolved, That the sum of forty-five dollars be and is 2 hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town 3 of Gray for money paid on account of Willis Anderson, a 4 State pauper.

Be it further resolved, That the sum of twelve dollars be 6 and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing 7 the town of Gray for money paid on account of Grover C. 8 Borborick, a State pauper.

Be it further resolved, That the sum of eighty-five dollars 10 and fifty-nine cents be and is hereby appropriated for the 11 purpose of reimbursing the town of Gray for money paid 12 on account of Herbert M. Verrill of Riley Plantation, a 13 State pauper.

GRAY, ME., January 25, 1907.

Hon. Francis H. Witham, State Legislature, Augusta, Me.:

Dear Sir—We have a claim against the State of Maine on account of Herbert N. Verrill, a State pauper, for \$85.59. This is a continued case. The State reimbursed Gray, by a resolve, (see chap. 112, page 39, Laws of Maine, 1905), for \$117.42 for Verrill, and the above \$85.59 was contracted later. We enclose statement of amounts paid. Please advise what evidence from us in this case is needed. The evidence in 1905 is probably on file at Augusta.

We have a case of an Indian, Willis Anderson, drowned in Sebago Pond, summer of 1905, by which Gray incurred an expense of \$45.00. We believe the State should reimburse us (see statement of amounts).

Also, a case of out-of-state pauper, Grover C. Borborick, (Boston, Mass.) At this date in this case we have not all the items of expense, amount to some \$12.00.

Please take these cases up for us and oblige,
