## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for the appointment by the Governor of a Committee to inquire into the advisability of creating a State Board of Charities and Corrections.

---

*Resolved,* That a special committee of five be appointed 2 by the Governor to inquire into the advisability of creating a 3 State Board of Charities and Corrections similar to that 4 suggested by Senate Document No. 36, 1907.

*Resolved, further,* That said committee have power to summons witnesses, demand the production of papers and documents and be authorized to sit after the adjournment of the 8 present legislative session. Said committee shall report by 9 bill or otherwise, which report shall be filed with the clerk 10 of the House not later than December one, nineteen hundred and eight, and be referred to the next Legislature without further action thereon. 12

*Resolved, further,* That to defray the expenses of said  
14 committee the sum of one thousand dollars be and is hereby  
15 appropriated.
