## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter two hundred and thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three as amended by Chapter 355 of the Private and Special Laws of 1905, authorizing the County Commissioners of Cumberland County to erect a county building in Portland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. Chapter 213 of the private and special laws 2 of the year one thousand nine hundred and three as amended 3 by chapter three hundred and fifty-five of the private and 4 special laws of one thousand nine hundred and five is 5 hereby amended by striking out the words "six hundred" 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'eight hundred and 7 fifty' so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'I. The county commissioners of the County of Cumber-9 land are authorized to erect and maintain in the city of 10 Portland a county building of modern, fire proof construc-II tion, containing suitable court rooms, registries, county offi-12 ces, library rooms and such other rooms, accommodations 13 and conveniences as to such commissioners may seem neces-14 sary or desirable, and for that purpose to acquire suitable 15 land, either by purchase, exchange, or by taking as for 16 public uses, and in order to provide for the payment thereof 17 to borrow money and issue interest bearing bonds of said 18 county to an amount not to exceed in the aggregate eight 10 hundred and fifty thousand dollars and the rate of interest 20 on said bonds shall not exceed three and one-half per cent. 21 per annum. Said county commissioners shall cause any 22 land so taken to be surveyed, located and so described that 23 the same can be identified, and shall cause a plan and des-24 criptions thereof to be filed in their office and there recorded.

The filing of said plan and description shall vest the title 26 to said land in said county, or its grantees, to be held during 27 the pleasure of said county.

Said bonds shall be valid without first obtaining the con-29 sent of said county as provided in sections fourteen and 30 sixteen of chapter eighty of the revised statutes.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
