## STATE OF MAINE.

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE DOCUMENT No. 648.

Amend by striking out all sections after enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Section I. Amend section I by striking out the words

- 2 "Every policy of insurance issued to a resident of Maine by
- 3 any insurance company, except a domestic life or stock insur-
- 4 ance company," and inserting in place thereof the following
- 5 words, 'Every accident, health or casualty policy of insurance
- 6 issued to a resident of Maine by any insurance company,
- 7 assessment association or fraternal order' and by striking out
- 8 the words "Each application for such policy shall have
- 9 printed upon it or upon a slip attached thereto in large bold-
- 10 faced type the following words 'Under the laws of Maine,
- 11 each applicant for a policy of insurance to be issued here-
- 12 under is entitled to be furnished with a copy of this applica-

13 tion attached to any policy issued thereon,' so that said sec-14 tion I as amended shall read as follows:

Section I. Every accident, health or casualty policy of 16 insurance issued to a resident of Maine by any insurance com17 pany, assessment association or fraternal order which con18 tains a reference to the application of the insured, either as 19 a part of the policy or as having any bearing thereon, must 20 have attached thereto a correct copy of the application, and 21 unless so attached the same shall not be considered a part of 22 the policy or received in evidence.'

- 'Sect. 2. Amend section 2 by striking out the word "if" 2 and inserting in place thereof the word 'of' so that sec-3 tion 2 as amended shall read as follows:
- Sect. 2. Any person who knowingly or wilfully makes a 5 false or fraudulent statement or representation in or relative 6 to any application for accident, health or casualty insurance, 7 or who makes any such statement for the purpose of obtain-8 ing a fee, commission, money or benefit in a corporation 9 transacting such business in this state, shall be punished by a 10 fine of not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred 11 dollars or by imprisonment of not less than thirty days nor 12 more than one year, or by both such fine and imprisonment; 13 and a person who wilfully makes a false statement of any 14 material fact or thing in a sworn statement as to the death 15 or disability of a policy or certificate holder in any such 16 corporation, for the purpose of procuring payment of a bene-17 fit named in the certificate of such holder, shall be guilty of 18 periury.'
