STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to provide an additional term of the Supreme Judicial Court for the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

On and after January 1st, 1908, there shall be three terms 2 of the supreme judicial court held within and for the county 3 of Oxford instead of two terms as now provided by law.

Said court shall be held in said county as follows: 5 Paris on the second Tuesday of October and the second

- 6 Tuesday of May, and at Rumford Falls on the second Tues-
- 7 day of February.
