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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to extend the charter of the Merchants' Trust Company, and to change the name of some of the corporators.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the  
2 Merchants' Trust Company, located at Auburn, Andros-  
3 coggin county, Maine, which were granted by chapter three  
4 hundred and twenty-four of the private and special laws of  
5 nineteen hundred and three, approved March twenty-six,  
6 nineteen hundred and three, are hereby extended for two  
7 years from the approval of this act, and George C. Wing,  
8 John H. Litchfield, Seth M. Carter, George C. Wing, Jr.,  
9 David R. Hastings and Everett L. Smith, their associates and  
10 successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges  
11 that were granted by said original act, to be exercised in the  
12 same manner and for the same purposes as specified therein.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
