STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT to amend section 5 of chapter 203 of the Private and Special Laws of 1883 entitled "An Act to incorporate the Portland Trust Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 203 of the Private and 2 Special Laws of 1883 is hereby amended in the first sentence 3 thereof by striking out the words "fifteen trustees" and 4 inserting in place thereof the following words, namely, 'Not 5 less than fifteen nor more than thirty trustees, as may be 6 determined at each annual meeting,' so that said first sen-7 tence as amended shall read as follows, namely:

'All the corporate powers of said corporation shall be exer-9 cised by a board of not less than fifteen nor more than thirty

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10 trustees, as may be determined at each annual meeting, and 11 such officers and agents as they shall appoint.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
