

RESOLVE for State Pensions.

Resolved, That the sum of eighty-seven thousand five hun2 dred dollars be and is hereby appropriated to provide for
3 state pensions for invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows
4 and orphans, and the dependent children, parents and sisters
5 of deceased soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under exist6 ing law, for the year nineteen hundred and seven, and
7 eighty-seven thousand five hundred dollars for the year
8 nineteen hundred and eight.
