STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVES providing for the preservation of Regimental
Rolls in the Adjutant General's Office.

Resolved, That the adjutant general is hereby authorized
2 and directed under the advice and control of the governor
3 and council to provide for the preservation of the enlistment,
4 descriptive and muster rolls, and the monthly returns of the
5 regiments and batteries in the war of the rebellion, now on
6 file in the adjutant general's office.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars for the
8 year nineteen hundred and seven, and two thousand dollars
9 for the year nineteen hundred and eight, is hereby appro-
10 priated for the preservation of said rolls.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These resolves are substantially a renewal of the resolves approved March 8, 1905, for two thousand four hundred dollars for each of the years nineteen hundred and five and nineteen hundred and six. It is estimated by reason of the larger part of the work having been completed, that an appropriation of two thousand dollars yearly will carry on the work of preserving the rolls of the organizations from this state in the war of the Rebellion through a period of two years.
