IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

AN ACT for the protection of Deer in the Town of Isle au  
Haut, in the County of Hancock.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to hunt, chase, catch or  
2 kill, in any manner, any deer on any island within the limits  
3 of the town of Isle au Haut, in the county of Hancock, for  
4 a period of six years.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this  
2 act, shall be subject to the same penalties as provided for  
3 the illegal killing of deer under the general law.
