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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVEN.

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AN ACT to authorize the Great Northern Paper Company to own and operate mills in any county in the State and to hold stock in the Northern Maine Power Packet Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The Great Northern Paper Company, in addition to the rights, powers and privileges which it now possesses, is hereby authorized and empowered to build, acquire, own, maintain and operate mills for manufacturing purposes in any county and all counties in the State, also to purchase and hold shares of the capital stock of the Northern Maine Power Packet Company or any other similar corporation, with all the rights and privileges of a stockholder in such corporation.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
