RESOLVE, with reference to rebate of taxes to railroads.

Resolved: That rebates of taxes granted railroads by for-2 mer legislatures without regard to party to aid in the indus-3 trial and commercial development of the state, ought not on 4 principles of equity, and in justice to contracting parties and 5 innocent purchasers, be disturbed, but it is the sense of this 6 body that such rebates should neither be newly granted nor

7 extended in any manner that can be construed as an exemp-

8 tion from taxation.
